Bacoor closely monitoring at least 30 COVID-19 cases amid Delta fear

The city government of Bacoor, Cavite is monitoring at least 30 cases of COVID-19 after the Delta variant was detected in two residents from separate areas.



Confidence among the country's creditors and debtors—which has been shaken by the prolonged coronavirus pandemic—remained weak with bank lending declining for the seventh consecutive month in June, according to the central bank.
