At least seven companies, including conglomerate Metro Pacific Investments Corp., the Villar Group and Lucio Tan's MacroAsia, have expressed their interest in teaming up with the provincial government of Cavite for a \$10-billion project that would transform the Sangley Airport into a world-class international gateway.

Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla said that a total of seven firms have purchased bid documents for the Sangley Point International Airport Project as the deadline for interested parties to buy

the said documents lapsed last Nov. 11.

The seven companies are MPIC, MacroAsia Properties Development Corp.,

DASMARIÑAS CITY, Cavite - Malacañang Palace declared November 26 (Tuesday) a special non-working day here.

Proclamation No. 825, dated November 12, states that "it is but fitting and proper that the people of the City of Dasmariñas be given full opportunity to celebrate and participate in

the occasion with appropriate ceremonies."

The city is set to observe its annual butterfly-inspired "Paro-Paro" festival and founding anniversary on November 26, which city folks, tourists, and visitors are expected to participate in.

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Remittances up 3.9% to \$24.6B in 9 months

Dollars sent home percent from the \$2.5 billion reported in the same period last year. This brought personal remittances for the first nine months of 2019 to \$24.6 billion, up 3.9 percent from \$23.7 billion a year ago.

The central bank said that personal remittances from Filipinos either working or living abroad hit \$2.6 billion in September 2019, up 6.3 percent from the \$2.5 billion reported in the same period last year.

The data also showed that remittances from overseas workers—which are said to account for an estimated 10 percent of domestic economic activity, especially consumption—grew for every month of this year, except for June.

Remittance inflows from sea- and land-based workers with short-term contracts also contributed higher at \$5.3 billion this year compared to \$4.9 billion a year ago, the monetary regulator added.

Similarly, cash remittances coursed through banks by overseas Filipino workers

the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG).

The activity was a concurrence of the Provincial Planning and Development Office's Peace and Order and Anti-drug Abuse Council meeting in September 2019 which emphasized the need for the delivery of basic services in vulnerable areas to impede the influence and intrusion of terrorist armed groups.

This also paved the way for different government agencies to pool their resources for the delivery of basic services particularly to families living in the identified geographically disadvantaged communities.

The Basic Services Caravan held at Baran-

gay Sta. Mercedes Multipurpose hall and in the open grounds, offered medical consultation, tooth extraction, family planning, immunization and awareness campaign on dengue, non-communicable diseases and proper nutrition to the residents.

Medical, dental and technical volunteers from the Provincial Health Office (PHO) and the Philippine Medical Association Cavite Chapter catered to the medical and dental needs of the people while the BJMP Calabarzon Health Services Division led by CINSIP Edna Leonor provided dental services like tooth extraction, donated free medicines and free hair cut.

In addition, the Of-

fice of the Provincial Governor, Provincial Disaster and Risk Reduction Management Office (PDRRMO) and DILG distributed sleepers and backpacks, emergency kits, and bath towels while the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) provided free services such as manicure, pedicure, hair-cut and massage therapy for the indulgence of some residents.

Moreover, about 700 jobs needed of the assistance from the Municipal Civil Registrar for PSA documents application; seedlings distribution by the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist (OPA); anti-rabies vaccination by the Office of the Provincial Veterinar-

ian; livelihood training (dishwashing and liquid soap-making) and the feeding program from the Provincial Cooperative, Livelihood and Entrepreneurial Development Office (PCLEDO), DTI-Cavite and Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO); Philhealth Membership/Enrollment; and the advocacy program for teenagers by the Provincial Population Office.

Similar services were also provided to the residents of Barangay Pinagunahan in a simultaneous conduct of activities by the OPG-Extension Medical and Dental Mission Team led by Ms. Maribel Bernall together with PGC department heads of partner offices.

off owing to the city's long-running pro-democracy protests and the China-US trade war. The US and China are now working on sealing a partial trade deal.

Daniel Zhang, Alibaba Chief Executive Officer, said the group wanted to "contribute, in our small way, and participate in the future of Hong Kong."

"During this time of ongoing change, we continue to believe that the future of Hong Kong remains bright," he said.

The firm's shares are already traded in New York. The second listing in Hong Kong is expected to carry favor with Beijing, which has sought to encourage its current and future big tech firms to list nearer to home after the loss of companies such as Baidu to Wall Street.

In the statement, Zhang said that when Alibaba went public in 2014 it "missed out on Hong Kong with regret."

Mainland authorities have also stepped up moves to attract such listings, including launching a new technology board in Shanghai in July.

The listing comes after the city's exchange tweaked the rules to allow double listings, while Chief Executive Carrie Lam had also been pushing Alibaba's billionaire founder Jack Ma to sell shares in the city.

"The listing in Hong Kong will allow more of the company's users and stakeholders in the Alibaba digital economy across Asia to invest and participate in Alibaba's growth," the company said.

'Steady remittance' from Filipinos abroad brings in more dollars, says BSP

The amount of dollars sent home by Filipinos abroad continued to rise in September as both land- and sea-based workers remitted more cash to their local beneficiaries, according to the latest data from the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP). The central bank said that personal remittances from Filipinos either working or living abroad hit \$2.6 billion in September 2019, up 6.3 percent from the \$2.5 billion reported in the same period in 2018. This brought personal remittances in the first nine months of 2019 to \$24.6 billion,

up by 3.9 percent from \$23.7 billion from 2018. The growth in dollar volume being sent home by Filipinos overseas, said the BSP, "was driven by steady remittance inflows." These were mostly from land-based overseas Filipinos "with work contracts of one year or more," the BSP said. Remittance from this sector grew to \$18.8 billion from \$18.2 billion in 2018. The BSP data also showed that remittances from overseas workers—which are said to account for an estimated 10 percent of domestic economic activity

BSP ends policy-easing streak

The central bank last Nov. 14 kept its key interest rates unchanged, hewing closely to the pronouncement of Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas Governor Benjamin Diokno that monetary authorities were done with pumping the economy with liquidity this year.

At its meeting on monetary policy, the Monetary Board decided to maintain the interest rate on the BSP's overnight reverse repurchase facility at 4 percent. Accordingly, the interest rates on the overnight deposit and lending facilities were kept at 3.5 percent and 4.5 percent, respectively.

This decision was buttressed by the central bank's view that inflation had already bottomed out after being on a downtrend for most of 2019 and would start "normalizing" by next year.

"Latest baseline forecasts of the BSP continue to indicate that inflation is likely to settle within the lower half of the target band of 3 percent, plus or minus 1 percentage point for 2019 up to 2021, with the balance of risks to the inflation outlook leaning toward the upside for 2020 and toward the downside for 2021," the BSP said in a statement.

"Upside risks to inflation over the near term emanate mainly from the potential impact of the Africa Swine Fever outbreak on food prices and from potential volatility in energy prices amid geopolitical tensions in the Middle East," it added.

October sales rev up confidence of car, truck makers

Truck and car manufacturers sold 33,150 units in October this year, the biggest in monthly sales achieved so far as the market moved to recover from a recent slump.

This was according to a joint report by the Chamber of Automotive Manufacturers of the Philippines, Inc. (Campi) and Truck Manufacturers Association (TMA) released last Nov. 14.

"The current market demand for vehicles along with creative and aggressive sales and promotion efforts give us a positive outlook as we aim to sustain the growth trend for the remaining months of the year," said Campi president Rommel Gutierrez.

October sales went up by 8.1 percent from the same month last year, data showed. For the 10-month period,

volume sales reached 301,761 units, up 2.53 percent from the 294,311 units sold in the comparative period a year ago.

The recent figures give Campi and TMA, which both account for a bulk of the local industry's total sales, some optimism that 2019 would be a better year compared to 2018.

Passenger car sales dropped 0.2 percent to 90,400 units

for the January to October period. But this was cushioned by the 3.8 percent growth in commercial vehicle sales, which reached 211,361 units.

The auto industry was still trying to recover from last year's huge drop in volume sales, as demand fell under the weight of the Duterte administration's higher excise taxes coupled with high inflation rates.

Volume sales Industry (DTI) was dropped 16 percent considering.

Phoenix bottom line fell 30% in January to September

Phoenix Petroleum Philippines Inc. saw its net income for the first three quarters drop 30 percent year-on-year to P918 million this year from P1.3 billion previously, which was blamed partly on the government's tax reform efforts.

"The company continued to face headwinds during the quarter as the passed-on impact of TRAIN [Tax Reform for Acceleration and Inclusion law] I and II taxes put pressure on our competitiveness against the informal market," Phoenix chief operating officer Henry Albert R. Fadullon said in a statement.

"Hence, we support the government's initiative in closing tax leakages through the fuel

marking program that is being piloted," Fadullon said. "We look forward to its full implementation in February 2020 to redress such unfair practices."

He added that industry players also needed to observe a more stringent enforcement of regulations governing bonded warehouses and a rigorous crackdown on non-compliant players in the power industry volume and tax collection.

The country's three biggest oil firms in terms of market share — Petron Corp., Pilipinas Shell Petroleum Corp. and Chevron Philippines Inc. — have similarly expressed support for the fuel marking program.

Chevron, through

its Caltex operations, thanks to the opening of new fuel stations and regular retrofitting of existing ones. As of September, Phoenix counts 650 stations operating across the archipelago.

In the nine months to September, Phoenix racked up an operating income of P2.5 billion, up by 10 percent year-on-year while revenues jumped 13 percent to reach P73.2 billion.

Overall sales volume was 16 percent higher year-on-year — close to two-thirds (64 percent) were derived from Phoenix's foreign operations — but higher costs from increased fuel premiums weighed on the volume and margins.

Growth of Phoenix's retail business was pegged at 22 percent,

PXP Energy losses down 56% in Jan-September

PXP Energy Corp. and Matinloc as well as lower depletion cost in Galoc pushed down expenses by 46 percent year-on-year to P21.8 million amid the

lingering moratorium on petroleum exploration at Recto Bank.

The MVP group company's consolidated petroleum revenues were 32 percent lower, pending PXP call at P51.1 million this year from P106.1 million previously.

This was attributed to a 36-percent drop in output and 13.6-percent fall in crude oil prices at its Galoc production field as well as the plugging and abandonment of its Nido and Matinloc production wells.

PH sin tax scheme gets WHO's nod

The World Health Organization (WHO) has lauded the Philippines' efforts to impose higher excise taxes on alcohol and tobacco products as an international model for cost-effective promotion of health and reduction of non-communicable diseases.

In a report about the country's groundbreaking efforts, WHO said the Duterte administration's "actions to prevent non-communicable diseases in the Philippines are relatively cheap and cost-effective," adding that the scheme "identifies which policy packages

would provide the greatest returns on investment." This government's earmarking of excise taxes on alcohol, tobacco and nicotine vapor products for implementing universal healthcare makes the Philippines "a forerunner in allocating sin tax revenue to health programs," the report stressed.

The study comes as the departments of Finance and of Health jointly push for the urgent passage of Senate Bill No. 1074, which significantly raises "sin" tax rates on alcohol, heated tobacco and e-cigarette products.

"Most of these policy interventions are also WHO best buys: that is, effective interventions with a cost-effectiveness ratio of less than or equal to 100 international dollars per disability-adjusted life-year averted in low- and middle-income countries," the report said of the country's "sin" tax measures.

Meanwhile, the finance department also expressed support for the WHO report's recommendation of adopting comprehensive approaches to tackling non-communicable diseases.

Firm eyes partnership with LGUs for trash-fed power generation projects

Integrated Green Technology Inc. (IGTI), a homegrown waste management and renewable energy firm, is firming up partnerships with the provincial governments of Pangasinan and Cebu provinces to build several trash-fed

power plants that cost a total of \$230 million, or about P11.6 billion, with the latter's equity mainly the land that would host the projects.

"For Pangasinan, we are looking at a facility that can use 970 tons of solid waste a day," Jimenez said.

With 50 tons of

waste needed to generate one megawatt of electricity, he said the planned Pangasinan project would have a capacity of about 19 MW.

Jimenez said there were two prospective projects in Cebu, one in Mactan and another

in Aloguinsan, each at 120 tons daily or about 6 MW. However, design details such as throughput volume and generation capacity—are still being finalized.

These planned projects, Jimenez said, have full support from European funders, including the London-based Allied Project Services Ltd. "We anticipate financial closing in the first quarter of 2020 and expect plant operations to start in the first quarter of 2021," he added.
