## Students can now borrow to buy gadgets for online learning "The enhancement

Bank of the Philippines (Landbank) loan program for fuition expenses has been expanded so that parents and students alike can

also buy electronic gadgets for online classes.

In a statement last March 3, the state-run Landbank said its "Interim Students' loan for Tuition toward Upliftment of education for the Development of the Youth" (I-Study) loan would cover up to P50,000 per student for purchases of desktops, laptops or tablets to be used for online learn-

The ongoing Land ing. This new coverage will be part of the maximum loanable amounts of P150,000 per student or P300,000 per parent-borrower under 1-Study.

Also, students of legal age are now eligible to apply for the 1-Study program they meet eligibility requirements, Landbank said, as only students' parents and guardians were eligible to apply when the loan program was launched last year amid the harder times wrought by the COV-ID-19 pandemic.
