Cavite extends deadline for airport bids

The Cavite government has pushed back the deadline for proposals to build a new \$10-billion international airport in Manila Bay as it hopes to lure more offers.

The original Nov. 25 deadline for the project dubbed the Sangley Point International Airport was moved to Dec. 17 this year, an extension of about three weeks, said Jesse Grepo, legal officer and secretary of the local government's public private partnership (PPP) selection committee.

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BIR to miss 2019 collection goal

The Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) conceded last Nov. 26 that it could not collect all of the P2.32 trillion in taxes programmed for this year due to be low-target collections thus far from the excise taxes slapped on fuel revenue agency rose

During a House committee on ways and means briefing, Assistant Commissioner Alfredo V. Misajon of the BIR said that while the end-October tax take was still a "fairly good chance" that this would be met,

As for the 2019 target, Misajon said that while there was still a "fairly good chance" that this would be met,

the BIR eventually "may be slightly short."

Congressman chair and Albay Rep. Joey Salcedo promised a possible P100 billion short fall for this year while Misajon said it could be "almost P150 billion" or even more.

Misajon noted that from 2016 to 2018, the BIR managed to collect 95-96 percent of its annual targets.

As for the 2019 target, Misajon said that while there was still a "fairly good chance" that this would be met,

"But we will be exerting so much effort for ports,"

the rest of the year to meet our goal. The target is to meet or exceed the [programmed] collection.

Hopefully, with our programs we can have substantial take in the two remaining months," Misajon said.

Poverty rate falls to 16.6%

As the creation of better-paying jobs offset the impact of last year's high inflation episode, the poverty incidence rate in the country dropped to 16.6 percent in 2018, the government reported last Dec. 6.

At a national poverty threshold—the minimum income required to meet basic food and non-food requirements—of P10,727 a month for every family of five, National Statistician Claire Dennis S. Mapa said the poverty rate declined from the updated 23.3 percent in 2015, based on 2012 prices.

The reduction in poverty incidence translated to 17.6 million poor Filipinos as of last year, lower than 2015's 23.5 million.

National Economic and Development Authority (Neda) Undersecretary and officer-in-charge Adoracion M. Navarro said 5.9 million Filipinos were lifted out of poverty between 2015 and 2018, a faster pace of poverty reduction as the government had targeted to bring down the rate to 14 percent by 2022 by improving the livelihood of six million Filipinos.

"With a poverty reduction rate of 2.3 percentage points per annum, we are not only on track to meet our PDP [Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022] target,

Inflation ended downturn, inched up in November

Inflation inched up to 1.3 percent year-on-year in November as base effects from last year's elevated rates wore out and prices of cigarettes and alcoholic drinks rose nationwide alongside increasing prices of alternatives to pork amid the African swine fever (ASF) scare. The rate of increase in prices of basic com-

modities last month was the highest in three months, bringing the end-November headline average to 2.5 percent within the government's 2.4 percent target range. November inflation picked up from the 42-month low of 0.8 percent in October but still lower than the 6 percent posted a year ago.

As this developed,

the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP)—whose interest rate policy is one of the key determinants of the cost of goods and services—said it expected consumer prices to move higher in the final month of the year, but ease in the new year.

"The latest inflation

outturn remains consistent with the BSP's prevailing assessment that inflation has bottomed out in October and is expected to gradually approach the midpoint of the target range in 2020 and 2021," the central bank said.

"The risks to the inflation outlook are on the upside for 2020, but ease in the new year.

In November, pric-

es of tobacco jumped 17.6 percent, which National Statistician Claire Dennis Mapa attributed to the impact of higher excise slapped on these "sin" products under the Tax Reform for Acceleration and Inclusion Act.

Growth may return to 7% level in '20, Sun Life exec says

The Philippine Life of Canada said the economy may return to the 7-percent growth trajectory for the first Stock Exchange index time in six years in 2020 (PSEI) to a new record assuming that the government budget delay that gnawed on production prospects could happen again, an investment expert from Sun Life of Canada

Philippines chief investment officer Michael Enriquez said in a briefing last Dec. 6.

The PSEI outlook suggests that investors will be willing to buy local blue-chip stocks at 18.2 times the projected average corporate earnings per share next year,

he said. "Next year will be a much more favorable year for Philippines. Hopefully, we will see 2 percent (growth) again," he said.

This year, Enriquez expects the domestic economy to grow by 3.8 percent for the full year,

Enriquez said the risk to bank and property out for 2020 would likely continue to be a potential US recession, which could be shallow and short-lived. He said: On the domestic front, there could be higher growth factors in spending while the decline in input costs will be good for the production big ticket projects, he said.

The stock brokerage made its way back to the 7,800 level last Friday as demand for large cap stocks returned in the aftermath of the MSCI rebalancing.

The main share Philippine Stock Exchange index (PSEI) ticked up 129.09 points or 1.68 percent to close at 7,836.89 despite some P105 billion worth of net foreign selling for

the day.

With the dust settling from the recent MSCI rebalancing, local stock brokerage firms said the PSEI should finally see

some upside and gain traction in the next few days."

Continued optimism from US markets should also provide a boost to the region with the S&P500 and Dow

PH-Korea free-trade deal delayed

The Philippines will not sign a free-trade agreement with South Korea this year, a disappointing end that came months after both sides vowed to sign a deal last Nov. 25 at an international summit in Busan, South Korea.

Instead, both countries will sign what Trade and Industry Secretary Ramon Lopez called an "early achievement package," which is essentially a progress report on the free-trade agreement (FTA).

This is not what both the government and the business sector expected, especially after the two countries expressed confidence to finish the FTA in just a matter of months. FTAs—which involve sensitive issues such as further opening a lo-

cal industry to foreign competition—usually take years to finalize.

Back in April, both the Philippines and South Korea announced that they would pursue a bilateral FTA, which they targeted to be signed at the Asian Republic of Korea Commemorative Summit.


The signing would have coincided with the 70th anniversary of the two countries' diplomatic relations.

The early achievement package to be signed on the sidelines of the summit simply means "agreeing to continue the discussion for next year, which means we won't be signing [an FTA] this 2019," Lopez told reporters recently, noting that the negotiations is still in a "stalemate."

The delay in the FTA talks did not come as a surprise. Back in October, Lopez told reporters that they were still confident when the start of the negotiations was announced. But a lot changed on the negotiating table since then, including South Korea's refusal to bring down the tariff on Philippine banana as within a five-year timeframe. Philippine banana currently have a 30-percent tariff to every South Korea.

E-commerce giant Alibaba's shares jump 7% in Hong Kong debut

HONG KONG — Chinese e-commerce giant Alibaba's shares jumped 6.6% in their debut on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange last Nov. 26, an auspicious start at a time when the former British colony is reeling from political unrest.

Alibaba closed at 187.60 Hong Kong dollars (HK\$196) per share after trading as high as 189.50 Hong Kong dollars. Its offering price was 170 Hong Kong dollars.

The company's shares already are listed in New York, where its 2014 IPO set a record at \$25 billion.

This offering of 500 million new shares raised more than \$11 billion in

Hong Kong's biggest listing since 2010 — a rare boost for the city after months of political unrest.

Charles Li, executive director and chief executive of Hong Kong Stock Exchange praised the company for carrying out the listing.

"I am very thank-

ful that Alibaba, after five years of planning, has finally come home. I'm also grateful that they choose to come despite the difficulties, despite the challenges that we are going through here in Hong Kong," Li said.

The closing price last Nov. 25 for Alibaba's New York-traded shares

was \$190.60 per share. Each of the U.S. shares is the equivalent of eight Hong Kong shares, which would put the price in Hong Kong terms at 168.50 Hong Kong dollars per share.

"The largest listing of the year comes at a very trying time for Hong Kong, but everything appears to be changing," he said.
