



PhilHealth coverage needs revision as debts mount—DOF

Health Insurance Corp. commonly known as PhilHealth, may need to revise its coverage as the state-run company struggles to pay off its debt, the government's chief economic manager said.

Finance Secretary Carlos G. Dominguez III said that Phill-lealth's massive spending to settle billions of pesos worth of benefits claims is unsustainable, saying this level of expenditures is only good for "several years."

"If it goes on for five years, I'm telling you, everybody has to change their lifestyles," Dominguez, who is also an ex-officio member of the PhilHealth board, told reporters.

The finance chief disclosed that Phil-Health is now "struggling with their own systems to pay off their current debts" after increased amid the pan-actuarial audit.
