opening its residential and retail complex project in Bonifacio Global City, and commercial proj-

"We also have very good partnerships with local conglomerates and we are open to some of them," he added.

GT Capital re-turned its 51% stake in Pro-Friends in exchange for the 702-hectare land earlier this month. Manila-Cavite Express explaining that rising property prices no longer make their land bank suitable for affordable housing projects. It noted that land values of other property players completed in 2022, in the area range from P17,000 to P52,000 per square meter.

The transaction is still awaiting approval from the Philippine Competition Commission. Once approved, the company plans to de-

into a mix of mid-rise residential properties and commercial proj-

ects that will target the mid-income segment.

"Ongoing infra-structure projects may translate to higher land

prices in the medium-term," the company said.

These infrastructure projects include the CAVITE-C-5 South Link that will both be finished by 2021, as well as the Cavite-Laguna Expressway that will be completed in 2022.

Meanwhile, Mr. Bautista said the remaining parcels of land in Metro Manila can be developed into high-rise condominiums by Federal Land. These are located in Shaw

Boulevard, Santolan, and along Daang Hari road.

April budget surplus hits P86.9B

The budget surplus released last May 24 posted by the national government in April—the month during which revenues were historically higher due to the yearly tax-paying deadline—almost doubled to P86.9 billion as underspending persisted that month due to the delayed approval of this year's budget.

Total revenues inched up by a mere 0.4 percent year-on-year to P308.7 billion as the non-tax take slid 25.7 percent to P19.8 billion.

For instance, the latest Bureau of Treasury's income in April declined by 26.5

percent year-on-year (BOC) increased 10.4 percent to P51.7 billion. In the case of the BOC, the Treasury attributed its higher take to "stringent monitoring and continuing efforts to enhance revenue-collection capabilities and intensified control measures against undervaluation, misdeclaration and other forms of technical smuggling."

As for tax revenues, the Bureau of Internal Revenue's collections rose 1.2 percent to P288.9 billion, while the import duties and other taxes collected by the Bureau of Customs

'Hot money' net inflows drop 97% as of April


